The Information and Communications Technology Council (ICTC) is a not-for-profit national centre of expertise for the digital economy in Canada.

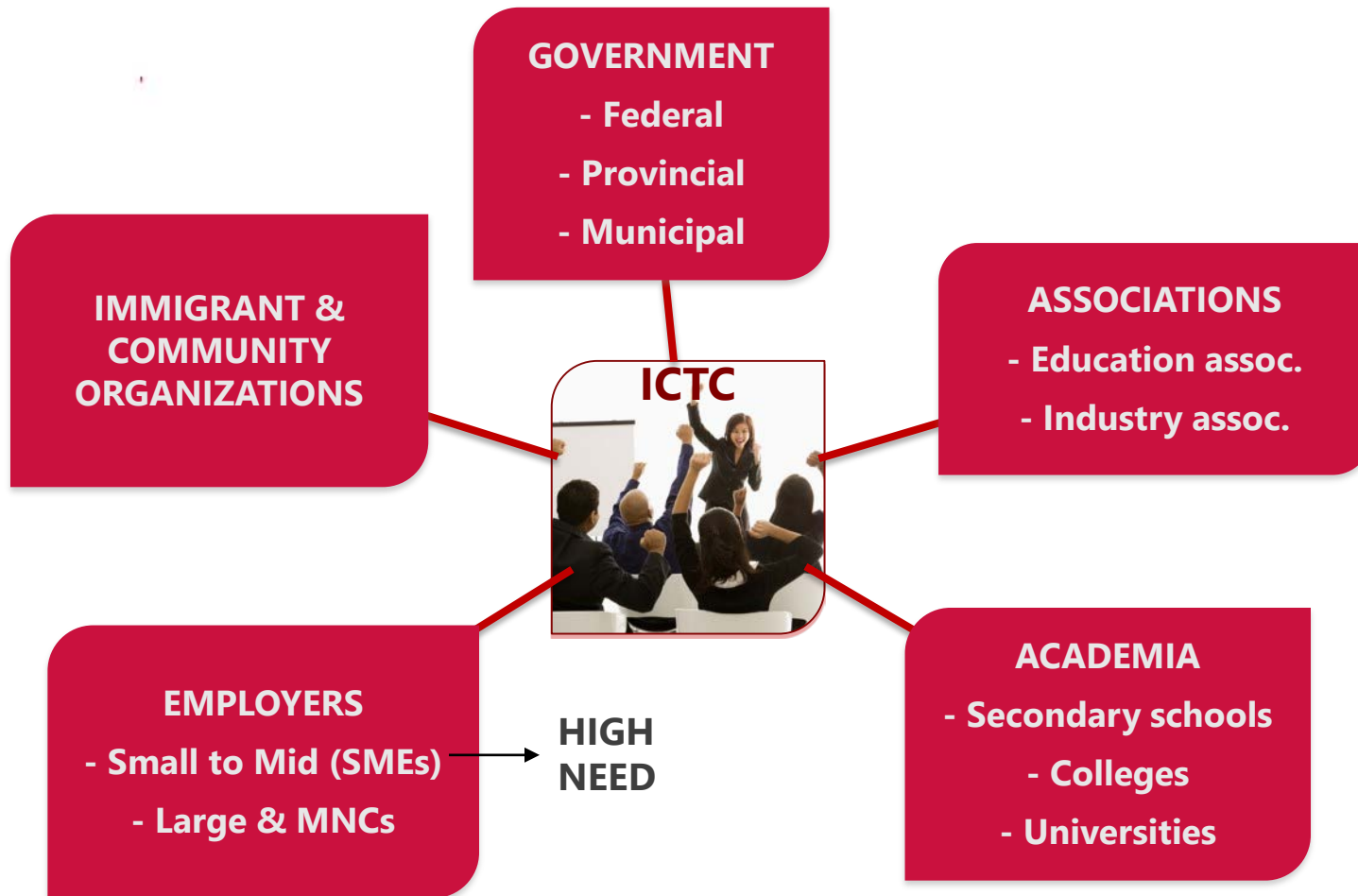

- Unemployment rate among immigrants in ICT jobs: 2.84%

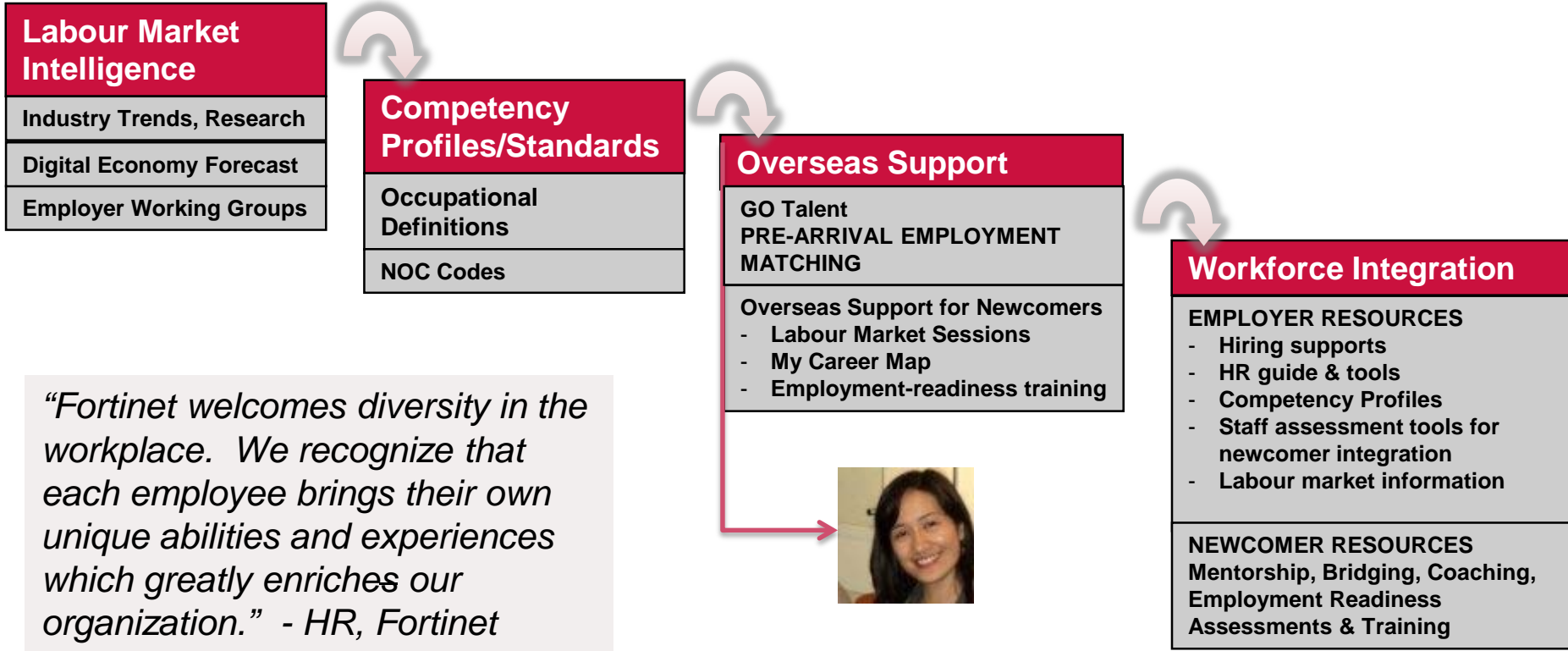

- Virtual interview guidance



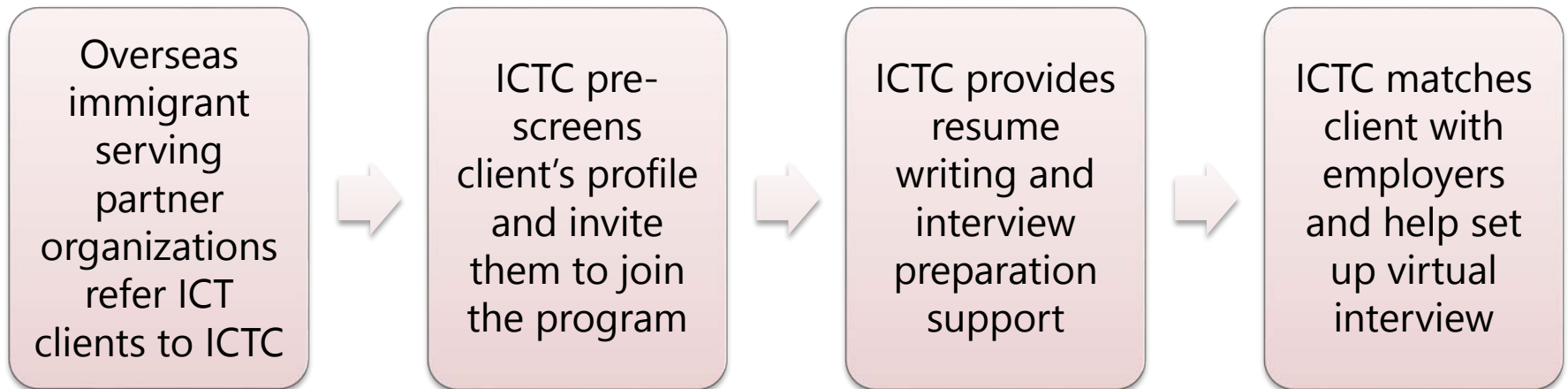
